Re: AB 60 (Alejo): Implementation Process

Dear Ms. Shiomoto:

The passage of AB 60 (Alejo) marked a major victory in the decades long effort to enhance the civil rights of immigrants in California. Undoubtedly, the policy change was desperately needed. Now immigrants across the state will have a safe and secure way to take their children to school and get to work.

In light of the urgent need for driver's licenses, we respectfully request that you expedite the development of regulations and commence accepting applications for licenses as soon as possible. We understand that a program of this magnitude presents technical and staffing challenges as more than one million new individuals will be eligible for driver's licenses. Nevertheless, with the support of community groups and local governments across the state we have full confidence that the Department of Motor Vehicles will be able to accelerate the process by several months. Such an effort will improve road safety for all Californians and address a longstanding need in our communities.

In addition to our collective desire to see this critical legislation implemented on an expedited basis, we have an interest in ensuring that recipients of these licenses are treated in an equitable and just manner by all law enforcement agencies. In fact, safeguards were specifically put in place to deter discrimination by public agencies against individuals with these new licenses. As such, we look to the Department to reinforce the Legislature's intent to have all state and local entities recognize these documents as they would any existing driver's license.

Lastly, by reinstating driving privileges to undocumented immigrants California is taking a step forward in protecting the rights of all residents. Yet to guarantee the success of our goals, this new program must be implemented with a heightened sensitivity to privacy concerns. Indeed, the undocumented immigrant population faces unique challenges that cannot be disregarded. With that in mind we urge you to work with immigrant advocates to address those challenges. Through a collaborative process, we are confident the Department will be able to develop a program that truly meets the needs of the immigrant community.

Given the importance of these issues we request a meeting to discuss how we can assist you in achieving a comprehensive and expedited implementation of AB 60. Our staff will be in contact soon to explore a mutually convenient time to meet.
