A working family from San Joaquin Valley will retire their older high-polluting vehicle and trade up to a more efficient vehicle. Senate Pro Tem Kevin de León will deliver the keys to the family's newly purchased Toyota Prius Plug-in Hybrid, and the old car will be crushed on-site. This was made possible by SB 1275 (De León) & SB 535 (De León), legislative efforts to increase access and ensure that low-income Californians, who are disproportionately impacted by air pollution, benefit from California's transition to clean transportation.
