



SB 535 (De Leon) Investing in Disadvantaged Communities

Millions of dollars from AB 32 funds targeted to state’s most polluted and economically poor neighborhoods. SB 535 requires the state to identify these neighborhoods using a combination of environmental pollution and socioeconomic information. The bill also ensures that the state invest no less than 25% of AB 32 cap-and-trade funds to benefit these communities.
